About FRP and the reclaimed paint project

FRP is a social enterprise and charity with environmental and social aims based in East London. The Paint Place is an FRP project, which diverts left-over paint from landfill and waste streams. FRP collects surplus paint locally. This is then sold as a more environmentally sustainable and low-cost alternative to new paint, particularly to individuals living on lower incomes, not-for-profits and community groups.

Role

To help collect, sort, and mix re-usable paint so it can be redistributed for use in the local community.

Main tasks

- Sort and store paint
- Quality check and mix paint using hand tools, including cordless drills
- Label the pots and paint their lids to show customers what they contain
- Prepare customer orders
- Clean tools, keep the space tidy and dispose of waste

Skills required

- Good verbal communication skills, basic literacy and numeracy
- Flexibility, reliability and punctuality
- Ability to work as a member of a team, but without constant supervision
- Ability to carry out instructions and ask for help as needed
- Ability to distinguish between different colours and types of paint
- Good spatial awareness and willingness to undertake messy, physical work

Volunteer support

- Induction and on-the-job training
- Volunteer expenses (up to £3 for lunch, and £5 for travel per day)
